ACADEMIC CALENDAR AND CURRICULAR ASPECTS

First Semester (March to July)	Lectures term: March 1 st to June Examination period: last week of June – first week of July
Second Semester (August to December)	Lectures term: August 1 st to November Examination period: last week of November – first week of December
Required credit hours per semester	Between 12 and 18 (Each UCSH course has 4 or 6 credits, so the student must take at least 3 courses)
Language of instruction	Spanish

Evaluation system	From 1 to 7, which is the maximum grade. The minimum passing grade is 4.0, and at least 70% attendance is required.

Step

1

You must inform your interest in applying to UCSH to your university's international office. You must have previously reviewed our academic offer.

Step

2

Your university's international office will provide us with your details and we will contact you.

Step

3

We will send you an email with application instructions. Please consider the following dates:

- Until **October, 31st** for the first semester (March-July)
- Until **May, 31st** for the second semester (August-December)

Step

4

After reviewing your background, we will inform you the result and submit to you the Letter of Acceptance if you were accepted. This letter will be the essential document to process the student visa at the National Migration Service of Chile.

SERVICES AND PROGRAMS AVAILABLE TO EXCHANGE STUDENTS



Food scholarship, which will allow you to have lunch at the university's cafeteria on the days you have classes. The mobility office will guide you to obtain this scholarship from the Finance Department and arrange the days you will have lunch at the university.



University ID, which will allow you to use university facilities and access other necessary services for university life.



Complementary learning opportunities, to boost the performance of all students. They include mentoring activities, workshops to improve communication skills, and initiatives to develop autonomous learning strategies.



Extracurricular and mental health workshops soccer, volleyball and basketball teams, psychological care spaces, cultural events, and student clubs.



You will also have the opportunity to participate in groups of the **university community** for social action and volunteering in squatter settlements, organized by the Pastoral Universitaria (University Ministry).
